(2) NO Stock available in Govt. Hospitals.(3) Looking to the Severe condition of the patient such medicines are highly needed according to the medical advice.
B	Newborn & Child Care	Financial assistance for Neo Intensive Care Unit (NICU) & Pediatric Intensive Care Unit (PICU)	(1) If Pediatrician is not available in Govt. Hospital (2) If NICU/PICU/ICU items like does not exists. (3) If Neo Ventilator is not available.
C	Orthopaedic Surgery	To provide Implants & Surgicals like Ball, Screw, Plates, Nails, Wires, Cement, etc.	(1) If Orthopedic Surgeon is not available in Govt. Hosp. (2) Implants/surgicals are chargeable in Govt. Hosp.
D	Body Investigations	MRI, CT Scan, Echo Doppler, USG, Biopsy, Pathology, EEG, PET Scan, X-ray, Dialysis, Barium Swallow etc.	Doctor may take action for further treatment after such diagnosis/investigation
E	General & Complicated Surgery	Neuro, Uro, Hernia, Absces, Tumors, ENT Cutting of Leg / Fools, Gangrenes, Post Burns etc.	(1) If General Surgeon is not available at Govt. Hospital (2) In case of non-availability of a nesthetist in Govt. Hosp. (3) If Specialist surgeon like Neuro, URO, Pediatric is not there in Govt. Hospital.
F	Emergency Hospitalization	ICU & ICCU admission of Poor & Needy	(1) If such facility is not available in Govt. Hospital. (2) If full time Physician is not there. (3) If multiple diseases found in one patient.
G	Shifting of patients	Ambulance Provision	To shift needy patients from Govt. Hospital to other Speciality Hospital in-case of non availability of Doctors, Surgeon, Infrastructures in Govt. Hospital.
H	Nutrition & Clothing Kit	Wheat Flour, Ghee, Sugar, Lady Gawn, Zula with Mosquito net, Baby cloths, Bed Sheet etc.	Highly anaemic mother / child requires some nutritious food for upgrading feeding rate Clothing & comforts may support to maintain hygiene.
I	Blood Arrangement	To arrange blood donor & pay up its Transfusion Charges	Blood is a common requirement for both surgical & Anemic patients. At any hospitals patient has to pay for Blood Transfusion Fees.
J	Hygienic Food	DIET for Indoor Patients & food for their care takers	Lunch, Dinner, Tea & Milk (twice/day) with Bread Slices & Biscuits.
K	Medical Allied Service	Surgical, Blankets in Winter, Tarpaulin in Monsoon, Grocery Kit for Aged Poor Couples / Widows, Protein kit for TB Patients & HIV Affected Patients etc.

(1) For above services, less earning professionals like Farm labors, Loaders, Helpers, Hawkers, Orphans, Semi orphans will be considered for help extension.

(2) For above (A), maximum help ceiling for one needy patient will remain INR 5000-5500/-

(3) For above (B), maximum help ceiling for one needy child patient will remain INR 8000-10000/-

(4) For above (C), maximum help ceiling for one needy ortho patient will remain INR 8000-10000/-

(8) For above (H), Kit expense for one pregnant lady who must be registered Indoor Civil Hospital patient will remain INR 550/-

(9) For above (G), maximum help ceiling for shifting of one patient will remain INR 4000/-
